AE-6 reactor (KEWB) failure on March 25, 1959 was a large worker exposure. No workers wore gloves or protective clothes. The reactor room got so hot that the doors were flung open to release the radiation. The workers had contamination on their hands, face and clothes. There was no monitoring in the reactor.
