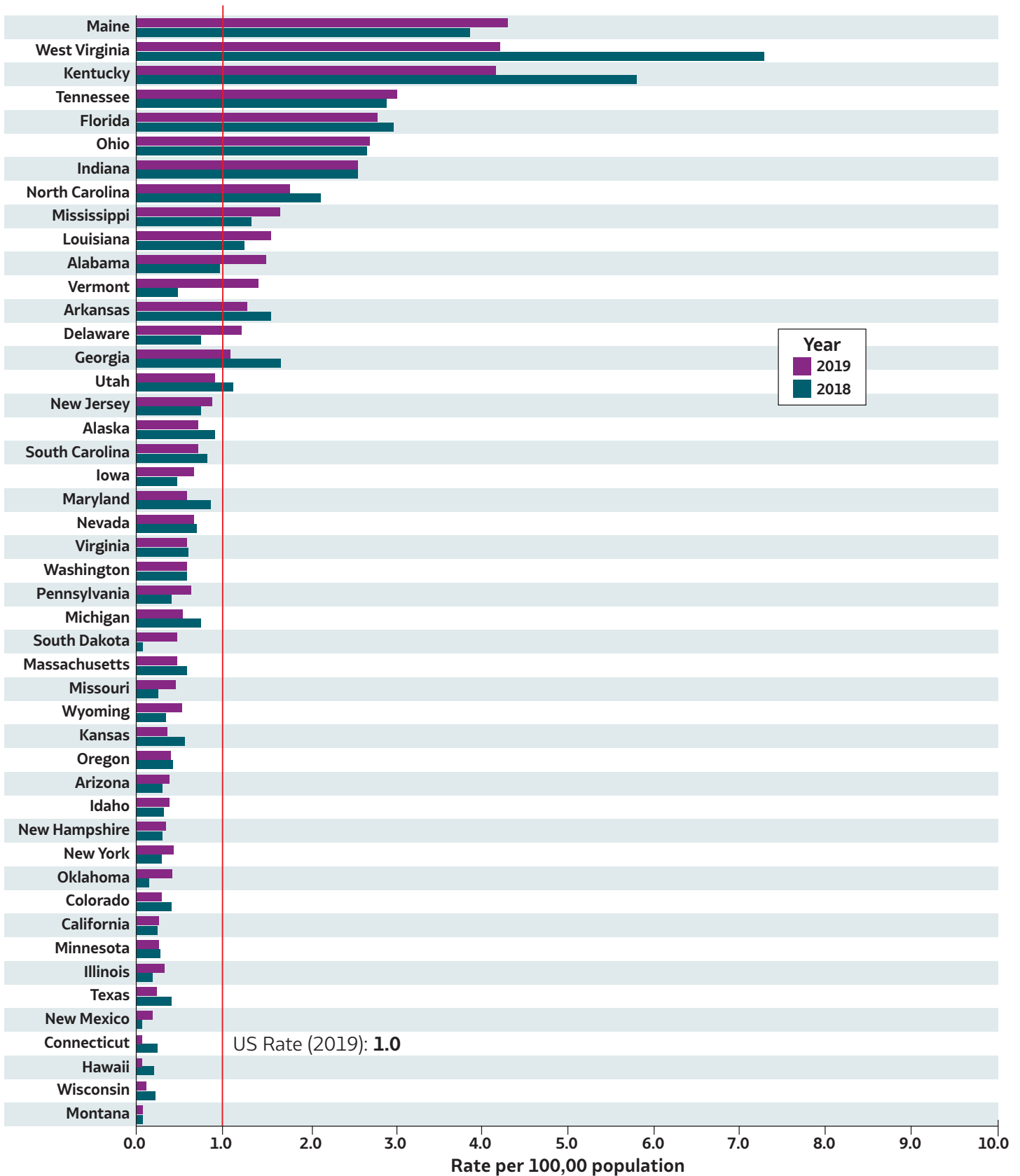


Figure 2.2. Rates* of reported acute hepatitis B⁺ virus infection, by state — United States, 2018–2019
