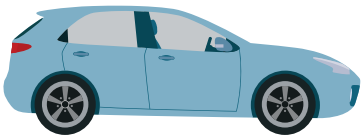

The doctor gives me a COVID-19 shot.

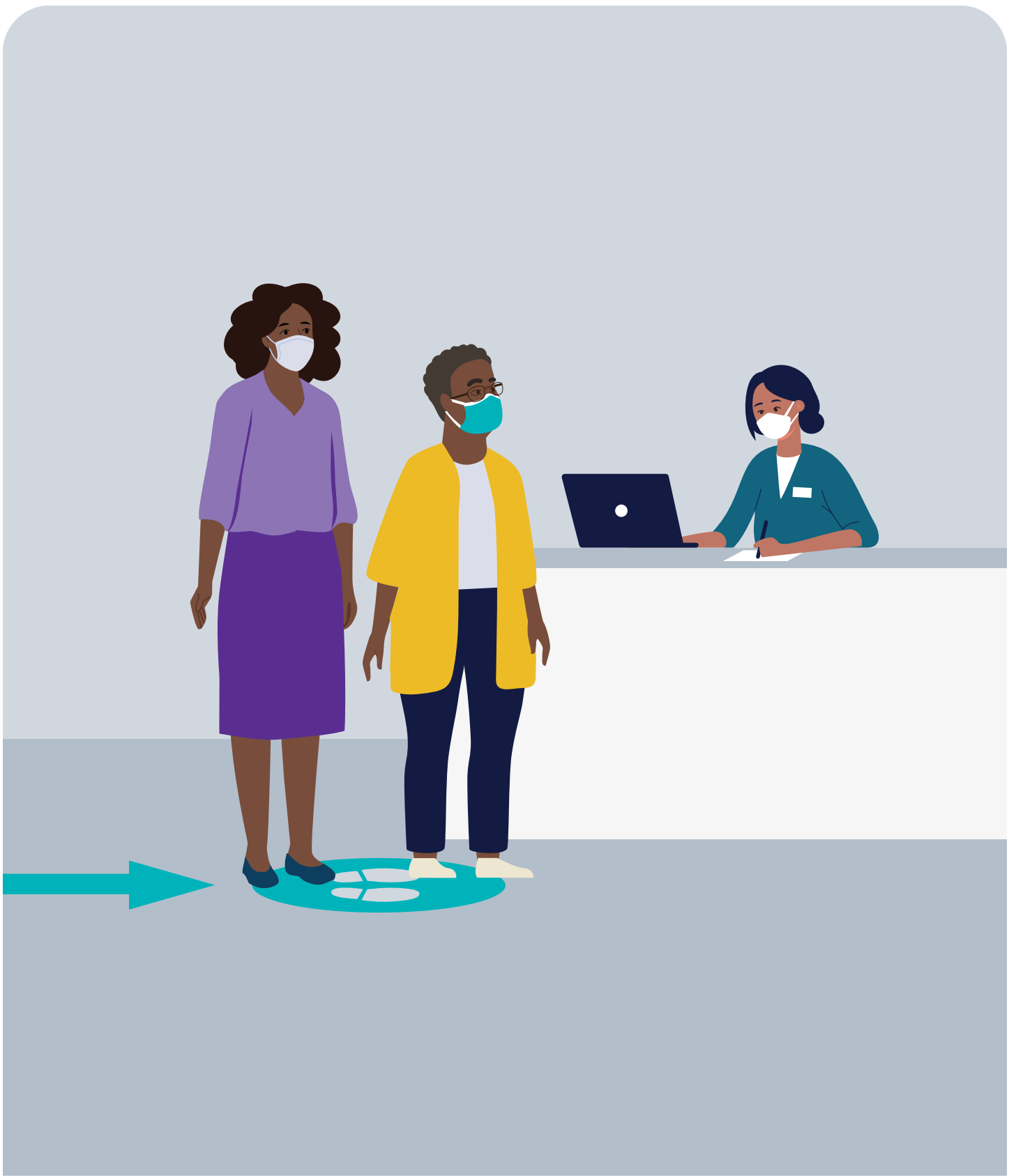
The shot helps keep me from getting very sick from COVID-19.

I got my COVID-19 shot. You can too.

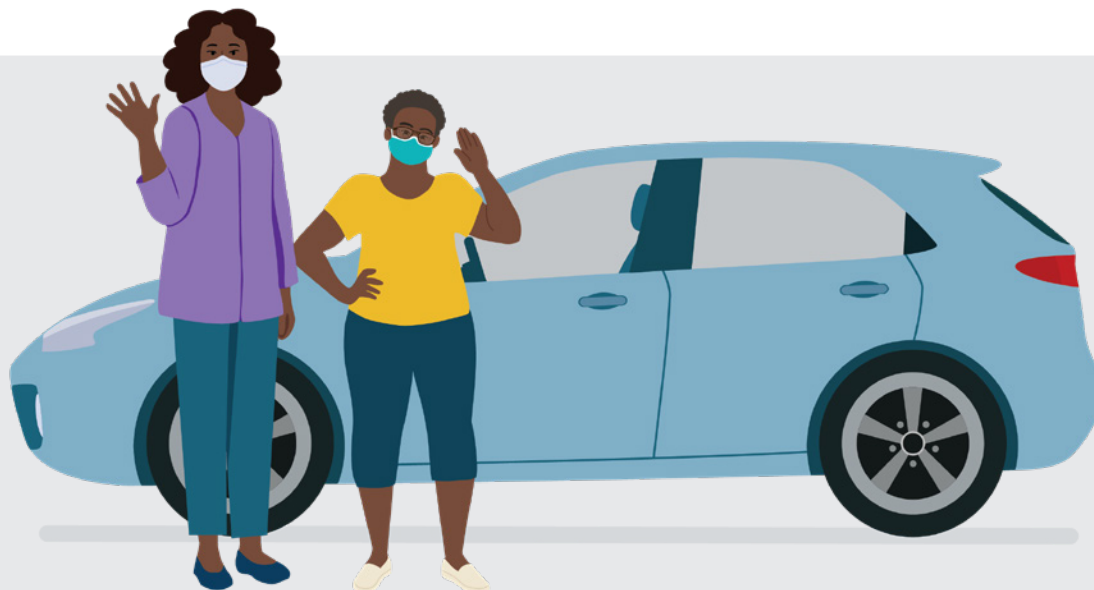

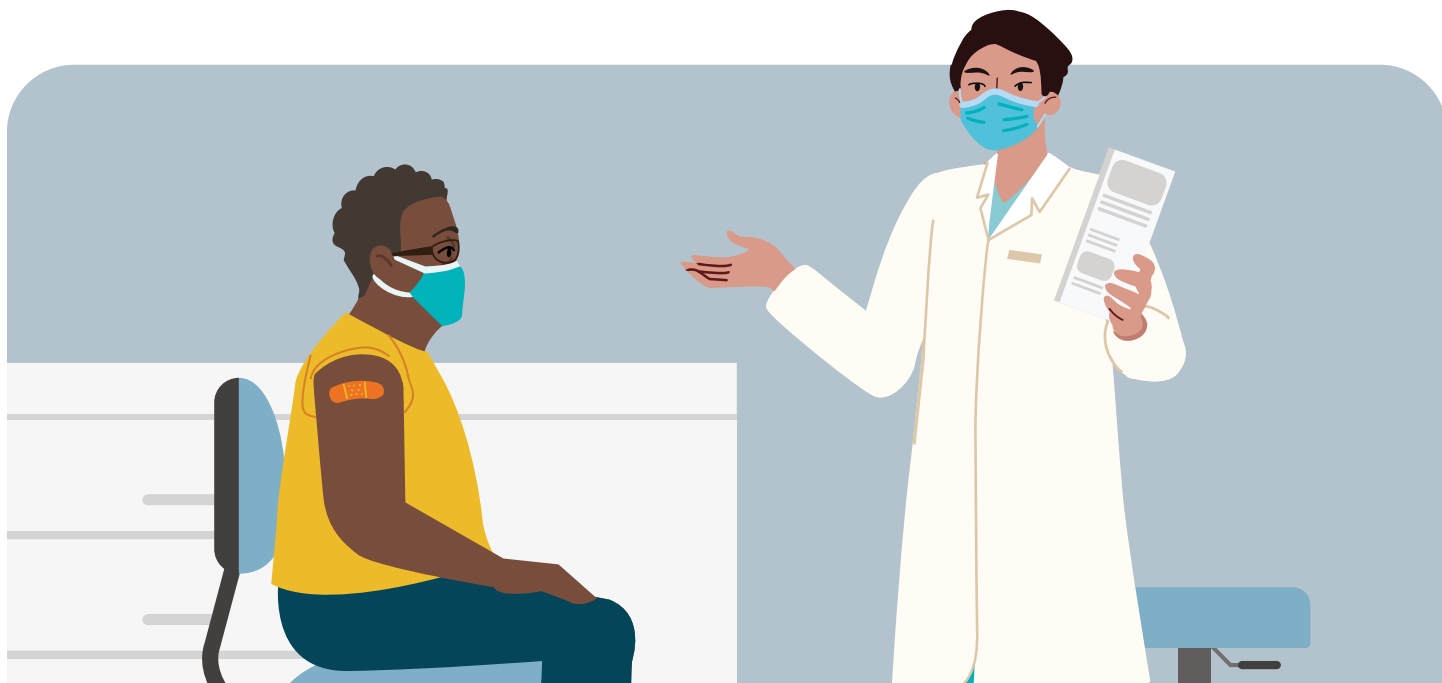
