Location Mapping

The following instructions are a step by step guide on how to map/add a new CDC Location in NHSN. Please refer to <u>Location chapter</u> in the PSC Manual for CDC locations and descriptions and instructions for mapping patient care locations

Steps

- 1. Go to your NHSN Home page.
- 2. Scroll down to "Facility" and Select "Locations"



- 3. On the Locations Manager page, enter the following;
 - a. Your Code A code to identify your location at your facility;
 e.g. 2West
 - b. Your Label A description of your code; e.g. Medical Ward – West Wing
 - c. CDC Location Description CDC Location descriptions can be found in Chapter 15 of the NHSN Patient Safety Component Manual.
 - d. Status Select 'Active' to enable this location for reporting.
 - e. Bed size Enter the number of beds, and bassinets if applicable, set-up and staffed.
- 4. Click "Add" to add the location.
