### **CDC Updates PHEP ORR Implementation Approach for BP3**

CDC is reviewing its approach for implementing the expanded Operational Readiness Review (ORR), or PHEP ORR, which is scheduled to begin in Budget Period 3 (BP3). Given the realities of the current COVID-19 pandemic response, CDC is assessing whether the implementation approach it outlined to PHEP recipients in January is still feasible. At that time, CDC had planned to conduct a PHEP ORR pilot during Budget Period 2 (BP2) while finalizing other implementation details for the PHEP ORR launch nationally in BP3. Those plans included developing a new ORR online data collection system and disseminating interim PHEP ORR guidance during BP2 to help recipients prepare for the full PHEP ORR evaluation process in BP3.

As the COVID-19 pandemic continued, CDC put the PHEP ORR pilot on hold during the spring and modified PHEP Budget Period 1 program requirements. The PHEP program changes continue into BP2, including a modification of the PHEP planning scenario from anthrax readiness to readiness for a large COVID-19 vaccination campaign. CDC also set parameters for how COVID-19 response activities can help recipients meet select PHEP requirements and suspended MCM ORR site visits so recipients could focus resources on response activities.

Scaling back PHEP program requirements did not change the overall PHEP ORR 2024 operational readiness goal. However, CDC has incorporated the June 2022 MCM operational readiness goal into the June 2024 operational readiness goal for all 15 preparedness and response capabilities.

Work is progressing as planned for the new ORR online data collection system, which is scheduled to open on July 1, 2021, and internal and external training plans for the new system are being finalized. CDC also expects to release the interim PHEP ORR guidance in the first quarter of 2021. However, CDC has determined that the COVID-19 response has reduced the window for conducting an ORR pilot in BP2 as originally planned. Instead, CDC is considering a phased implementation approach in BP3 that will meet many of the objectives of the pilot and other PHEP ORR goals while reducing recipient burden.

With a phased implementation, CDC would conduct training sequentially during BP3 to familiarize recipients with each capability's ORR requirements, and recipients would enter data into the ORR system after completing the training. CDC is working on other implementation details, such as the process for engaging and reviewing local health departments.

CDC briefed PHEP recipients on its proposed phased implementation process during the monthly PHEP recipient call on November 18. Recipients can continue to provide input to DSLR via <a href="mailto:preparedness@cdc.gov">preparedness@cdc.gov</a>. CDC will provide recipients with additional information as planning for BP3 implementation progresses.
