CHRISTINE: Because his only parent, me – I became a dependent.

We now see a photo of Christine with her two grown children and the tumor along her jaw and neck is even larger.

CHRISTINE: My tip is, every time I wanted to smoke a cigarette I would think of my children.

The spot cuts to the art card, which reads "You're not just quitting for yourself."
