In this month's cover feature, "Evaluation of Respiratory Symptoms and Their Possible Association with Residential Indoor Bioaerosol Concentrations and Other Environmental Influences," the authors discuss indoor air contaminants of a biological nature, i.e., bioaerosols, and environmental factors and their relation to self-reported respiratory problems in the study population. Bioaerosols come from many sources including bacteria, fungi, pollen, and animal dander, and have been linked to "sick building syndrome" and building-related illnesses, which are EH healthy housing issues.
