Dear Larry:

Libby White asked me to send you the following information for the Advisory Board Meeting:

1) Information from our office's files about the Dow Chemical facility in Madison, Illinois: I am enclosing 3 paper copies (one for you, one for the Advisory Board, and one for SC&A). Senator Obama recently requested nine categories of documents and the copies enclosed are marked with the category to which each is responsive. The document marked "Category 9" is the document that forms the basis for Dow Madison being covered under the Energy Employees Occupational Illness Compensation Program Act.

2) Unclassified information from the DOE History Division Files:

I am also enclosing 3 CDs (one for you, one for the Advisory Board, and one for SC&A) which contain a copy of the contract that the Atomic Energy Commission (AEC) signed with the Dow Chemical Company for the operation of the Rocky Flats Plant. The CDs contain copies of the original contract, copies of modifications 1 through 20, and copies of modifications 92 through 112. This contract is what the History Division retrieved in response to November 26, 2006 request. The remaining modifications to the contract which are in Department of Energy custody repose in folders containing classified documents. They will be placed under declassification review next week, and we will be certain to provide copies of these modifications to you, the Advisory Board, and SC&A.

Our office has also forwarded Senator Obama's our request to DOE's Office of Legacy Management (LM). LM has recently inherited records created by the Rocky Flats Plant, and it is possible that these records may contain certain documentation responsive to his request. We will work with LM to ascertain whether they contain this documentation and will ensure any relevant information is provided to Senator Obama, you, the Advisory Board, SC&A, and
