# 1 in 6 Hispanic adults are caregivers

CAREGIVERS provide regular care or assistance to a FRIEND or FAMILY member with a health problem or disability

### **CAREGIVING CAN BE**

# **Nearly half**

have provided care for at least two years



## **INTENSE**

One third have provided care for at least 20 hours per week



### **WHO ARE CAREGIVERS?**

**58%** are women

**9%** are 65 years old or older

**39%** are caring for a parent or parent-in-law

**8%** of caregivers are providing care to someone with dementia



#### **HOW DO CAREGIVERS HELP?**



Nearly 80% manage household tasks

Over 50% assist with personal care
