Free resources to support communication and education efforts:

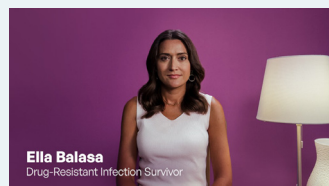
