

## Management of Dengue

Patients must meet all criteria of Group A or at least one of the criteria for Group B or Group C, to be assigned to a group.

### Dengue Management Groups

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Does not have coexisting conditions</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Has coexisting condition: diabetes mellitus, renal failure, or is infant, pregnant, or elderly</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Severe bleeding, as determined by clinician</li> </ul>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Receives adequate volume of oral fluids</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Has challenging social circumstances, such as living alone or living far away without a reliable means of transport</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Severe organ impairment: AST or ALT <math>\geq</math> 1000 or impaired consciousness</li> </ul>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Passes urine at least once every 6 hours</li> </ul>		
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Has stable hematocrit and hemodynamically stable</li> </ul>
