



The (*not so rare*) Epilepsies: Hard to Diagnose & Hard to Treat ECHO

Wish you knew more about diagnosing and treating rare or genetic epilepsy, Developmental & Epileptic Encephalopathies (DEEs), and epilepsy syndromes as well as their comorbidities?

The Epilepsy Foundation, Rare Epilepsy Network (REN), and the American Academy of Pediatrics (AAP) are recruiting neurologists (pediatric and adult), epileptologists, trainees, pediatricians, and other health professionals, to be a part of a **new** ECHO.

Project ECHO (Extension for Community Healthcare Outcomes) model[™] creates knowledge networks by connecting health care providers with an expert team through a tele-mentoring program using brief lectures and case-based presentations. These **"all teach, all learn"** networks have been shown to increase capacity for health care providers to identify, treat, and manage patient care. Each one-hour ECHO session consists of a short lecture (approx. 15-20 minutes) followed by a case presentation (5 minutes) and discussion.
