The Path to Safe Motherhood

The recommended elements of the Saving Mothers, Giving Life approach to preventing maternal and newborn deaths

Woman and Family

- Attend at least 4 antenatal care visits
- Make a birth plan, learn warning signs
- Set aside funds for transport and care costs



• Sensitise the costs

- Sensitise the community about safe delivery
- Community health workers provide information on safe delivery and services and pregnancy danger signs
- Community leaders are involved in planning and activities
- Financial programmes to help save for delivery costs
- Subsidize a voucher system for transportation and services

Health System

Ensure all facilities have:

- Routine or emergency delivery services available 24/7
- Sufficient staff, with continued training, so skills meet needs
- Essential medical supplies, equipment, and medication routinely available
- Effective referral and transport system for emergencies
- Build or upgrade maternity waiting homes and emergency obstetric care facilities (where appropriate)





• Delivery services available 24/7

Community

- Sufficient essential medical supplies, equipment, and medication
- Checklists for emergency triage and care
- Access to vehicle for emergency referrals to higher level care
- Maintain maternity waiting home (at higher level facilities)
