

The CSTOR Web Portal streamlines the specimen submission lifecycle, allowing for more visibility and coordination with state public health laboratory (SPHL) partners. This online alternative to the CDC 50.34 form removes manual processes and automatically tracks the status of each specimen from submission to reporting. In addition to SPHLs, Original Submitters (e.g., hospitals, medical centers, universities, local public health laboratories, commercial laboratories, etc.) are eligible to onboard with approval from the SPHL whose jurisdiction they fall under.
