<sup>5</sup>For 2007-2021 NHIS, eligibility for linkage is based upon providing the last four digits of SSN or an affirmative response to the follow-up question to allow linkage without SSN and providing sufficient PII for linkage.

<sup>6</sup>This group includes linkage-eligible survey participants who linked to HUD administrative records at any time during the linkage interval.

<sup>7</sup>Age at interview is categorized based on age variables on the public-use survey files. For NHIS 2019-2021, a small number of Sample Adult participants could not be categorized by age.

<sup>8</sup>For 1999-2006 NHIS, linkage was conducted for all linkage-eligible persons in the family (Person level), including Sample Adults and Sample Children. For 2007-2021 NHIS, only Sample Adult and Sample Child participants are included in the NCHS-HUD linkage.
