The NHSN Rebaseline Team has exciting news to share! The first group of Standardized Infection Ratio (SIR) reports using the new 2022 baseline will be available in the NHSN Patient Safety Component by the end of this week. This first group will consist of reports for the following healthcare-associated infections (HAI):

- MRSA bacteremia LabID Event
- SSI Complex 30-day model for adult inpatient colon (COLO) and abdominal hysterectomy (HYST)

A follow-up email will be sent to all NHSN Patient Safety Component users once the new reports are available. This subsequent email will provide information about upcoming training opportunities and newly posted educational materials that will help NHSN users utilize and interpret these new reports.

A quick reminder that the new SIR reports are being made available in the NHSN application for internal use by your facility and/or Group. No timeline has been announced regarding the adoption of the 2022 baseline SIRs by the Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services (CMS). The 2015 baseline SIR reports will continue to be available in NHSN, and the 2015 baseline SIRs continue to be used for current CMS programs.
