Program Updates (2 of 2)

- **EEOICPA CIRCULAR NO. 24-01:** Continue to authorize payment without pre-authorization to physicians who utilize telemedicine options for routine medical care
- **EEOICPA BULLETIN NO. 24-03:** Increased the maximum allowable authorization for home healthcare from a duration of 6 months to 12 months.
- **EEOICPA CIRCULAR NO. 25-01:** Metals and Controls Corporation Special Exposure Cohort (SEC) Class issued on 10/9/24 (Attleboro, MA)
- EEOICPA CIRCULAR NO. 25-02: Prior authorization before reimbursing for compounded drugs using Form OWCP-26
