## **NIOSH Response Overview**

NIOSH is in agreement with all four SC&A observations. SC&A identified zero findings.

## Summary of SC&A Supplemental Review Observations

- No additional sources of radiation exposure
- No potential for uptake of plutonium or other transuranic radionuclides
- No contracts indicating the need for additional health physics monitoring
- Noted that authorized petition representative-submitted documents – while providing useful background – did not contain information to suggest that worker doses cannot be adequately bounded

## Conclusion

NIOSH concurs with each observation, none of which contradict the conclusions presented in the SEC-00256 Evaluation Report. SC&A's review is consistent with NIOSH's position that dose reconstruction for Pinellas Plant workers is feasible. NIOSH recommends closing these four observations.
