How can I get ahead of sepsis?

Know sepsis signs and symptoms to identify and treat patients early.



Protect your patients by acting fast.

Act fast if you suspect sepsis.

Prevent infections by following infection control practices 3 (e.g., hand hygiene, appropriate catheter management) and ensuring patients receive recommended vaccines.
