
Introduction

This document contains an **action plan worksheet and summary worksheet** that awardees can choose to complete when using the Success Framework for Adult Immunization Partner Networks. These optional materials can help awardees review each key question, identify areas for improvement, and track progress on recommended actions.

Success Framework For Adult Immunization Partner Networks

The Success Framework for Adult Immunization Partner Networks (success framework) supports awardees in reflecting on adult immunization partner networks' current strengths and areas for growth or improvement.

Organized around the four phases of the partnership management lifecycle, the framework guides awardees through a series of **key questions** and **recommended actions** to strengthen and sustain partner networks.

Awardees can fill out these optional materials in coordination with partners to determine current progress, explore actions to address gaps or areas for improvement, and reflect on steps you will take to begin addressing gaps within your partner network.

Identify and distributed resources and/or trainings to build the identified skills/competencies across partners. Review analysis results with advisory group to understand partner network progress and guide decision-making on goals, objectives, and activities. 	 Use results of analyses to support partners in modifying activities to better support progress toward shared goals. Establish processes to gather feedback from partners on quality of support provided and identify additional areas for support. 	 Communicate the impact of partner network activities to leadership and potential funders to help scale and sustain effective partner activities.
