Where To Find Your Free COVID-19 Vaccine This Season

Updated 2024-2025 COVID-19 vaccines are now available to better protect you against serious illness from COVID-19. Visit <u>vaccines.gov</u> to find an updated COVID-19 vaccine near you.

Most people can get COVID-19 vaccines at no cost through their private health insurance, Medicare, and Medicaid plans. If you have private health insurance, check with your employer or insurance plan. Find a provider in your network before getting your COVID-19 vaccine to decrease or avoid out-of-pocket costs. If you do not currently have health insurance:

Uninsured? Free COVID-19 Vaccines May Still Be Available

CDC's <u>Vaccines for Children (VFC)</u> program provides vaccines at no cost to eligible children through healthcare providers enrolled in the program.

CDC is providing new funding for 2024-2025 COVID-19 vaccines for public health departments. Adults without health insurance or with insurance that doesn't cover all COVID-19 vaccine costs may be able to find a free COVID-19 vaccine. Here are ways you can look for a free COVID-19 vaccine near you:

Contact Your Local Health Department

There will be 2024-2025 COVID-19 vaccines available through <u>state and local health departments</u>. <u>Find</u> <u>a local health department</u> near you and contact them to ask if they have free COVID-19 vaccines available. Health departments may require an appointment or have an enrollment process so please call to ask about COVID-19 vaccine availability before going.

Find a Local HRSA-supported Health Center

<u>HRSA-supported health centers</u> provide care to patients regardless of their ability to pay at approximately 15,000 sites across the country. Most health centers have 2024-2025 COVID-19 vaccines available and adjust their fees based on income and family size. Find a health center near you at https://findahealthcenter.hrsa.gov/.
